



DOWNTOWN GRANT AND LOAN PROGRAM

Seymour Main Street, in collaboration with the City of Seymour and the Community Foundation of Jackson County, seeks to provide a combination loan and grant program to property owners in the downtown Seymour, Indiana.

The primary objective of the Grant and Loan Program is to revitalize the Downtown Area by preserving and restoring the existing buildings. We also seek to promote economic development within the district by providing financial loans to (a) encourage occupancy of vacant commercial buildings, (b) provide financial assistance to avoid the occurrence of a vacancy of a commercial building, (c) to encourage renovation and rehabilitation of commercial buildings, particularly storefronts.

- **Loan Program.**

The loan can equal up to \$10,000. The interest will be 3.00% per annum

- Facade
- Awning
- Signage
- Roof
- Rear Exterior
- Second Story Renovation

- **Grant Program.**

- Facade Grant:

The program will provide a matching grant for projects up to \$10,000 (\$5,000 grant).

- Awning Grant

The grant will provide 50% of cost or a maximum of \$1,000 whichever is less. Can be used in conjunction with the Facade grant program.

- Signage Grant

Like the awning grant, funds will be available for 50% of cost or a maximum of \$500, whichever is less.
